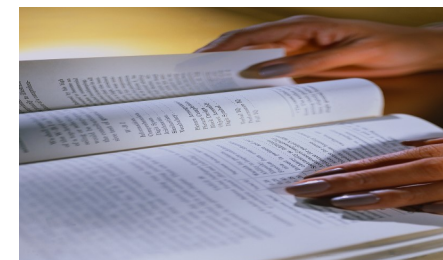

What is the High School Equivalency?

The HSE is an alternative for earning a high school diploma. Your HSE certificate can be earned after completing a test based on five subject areas including Math, Reading, Writing, Science, and Social Studies. The skills you are tested on are at the same level as those of graduating high school seniors.

Am I eligible to take the High School Equivalency test?

If you meet all of the following qualifications, you may take the test:

- You have lived in Indiana a minimum of 30 days before taking the test.
- You have **NOT** already earned a high school diploma from an accredited United States high school.
- You are at least 16 years of age. 16 and 17 year-olds must provide additional documentation, (see next page.)

How may I prepare to take the test?

You may enroll in an adult education program which provides free classes for adults who have not earned a high school diploma. For information on classes, call 317-988-7975. Classes are recommended, but are not mandatory.



How do I sign up?

Registration is done in person at the testing office,

Monday—Thursday, 12:00 PM—2:00 PM & 4:00 PM—6:00 PM. At the time of registration, you must provide a picture ID. An Indiana driver's license or Indiana State ID is preferred. If the ID is foreign or out-of-state, you will be required to provide additional documentation proving residency in the state of Indiana for at least 30 days. If you are 16 or 17 years of age, you must also bring an exit form with a Principal's signature from your last school and a Superintendent Recommendation form. Forms can be picked up at the registration office or downloaded at adulthood.info by clicking on the HSED tab and then scrolling to the bottom of the page. It is highly recommended that you create a HiSet account by going to <http://hiset.ets.org> prior to registering for the test. This site provides you with information to create an account, get study aides, and answers frequently asked questions.

How long is the test?

More than 7 hours are needed to complete the five tests. The test is given over a two-day period.

What are the subject areas tested?

- Writing
- Social Studies
- Science
- Reading

- Mathematics



What scores do I need to pass?

To earn your HSE certificate, you must pass each individual sub-test with a score of at least 8 points on each subtest and at least 2 points on the written essay. A combined score of 45 must be obtained. Seven to ten days after completing the test you will be able to view your results in your HiSET account on-line and a transcript will be mailed from Diploma Sender in 2-6 weeks.

What if I fail the High School Equivalency Test?

You may retest in any subject that you did not pass. You do not have to re-take the entire test. You must wait 30 days before retesting in the same subject and you are allowed to retake a subtest two more times, if necessary, within a calendar year at no cost.

Do I get a high school diploma if I pass the high school equivalency test?

If you pass, you will receive a High School Equivalency Certificate issued by the state of Indiana.
